Invitation to Serve on Membership Committee

The 1987 *Membership Rules* of the Band provide for a Membership Committee to be appointed by Council to review applications for discretionary membership in the Band.

The committee will consist of:

- (a) four Eligible Electors, each of whom represents one of the four major families of the Band; and
- (b) one impartial non-Band member who enjoys the confidence of the Band.

After its review of a discretionary membership application, the committee makes a non-binding recommendation as to whether the applicant is to be admitted to membership in the Band. That recommendation is provided by the Electoral Officer to the Eligible Electors to assist them in deciding how to vote on each individual applicant.

The appointment to the committee will be for a term expiring after the next Membership Admission Vote is held among the Eligible Electors of the Band.

According to the Band records, you are an Eligible Elector for this process, because you were admitted to membership in the Band, either:

- (i) prior to 1997;
- (ii) after 1996, as a person entitled automatically to membership under either sections 3 or 4 of the *Membership Rules*; or
- (iii) after 1996, in a membership admission vote approving your transfer in to the Ashcroft Indian Band from another Band/First Nation.

Council will also be appointing an Alternate Roster of persons who will be available to serve on the committee in the absence of any of its members.
